## Sprouts

## REQUIREMENTS

- Two players
- Pencil and paper


## GAMEPLAY

Two players begin by placing two or more dots on a sheet of paper. The dots should be spread out. Each player's turn consists of drawing a line between two dots (or from one dot back to itself), and then adding a new dot somewhere along the new line he has just drawn. The new line can be straight or curved, it doesn't matter. However, players must follow these rules:

- The line must not touch or cross itself or any other line.
- The new dot must be placed somewhere on the new line but not either end of the line.
- No dot may have more than three paths connected to it. A line passing through a dot (in and out) counts as two paths. A new dot that is added to a new line automatically has two paths connected to it. A line from a dot to itself counts as two paths.


## OBJECTIVE

The player who is unable to draw a new line loses.
